### Course Overview

To meet the business knowledge and experience requirement for a business condition under the Building Work Contractors Act 1995 you need to satisfy one of the criteria approved by the Commissioner for Consumer Affairs\*.

**This course aims to give you that knowledge.**

Upon successful completion of the required learning and assessment tasks for this course you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment which can be used as evidence in the application process for your Contractor's Licence.

The course can be delivered on-line, with **no classes to attend** and no lost time at work. On-line delivery is supported by a mentor (phone contact).

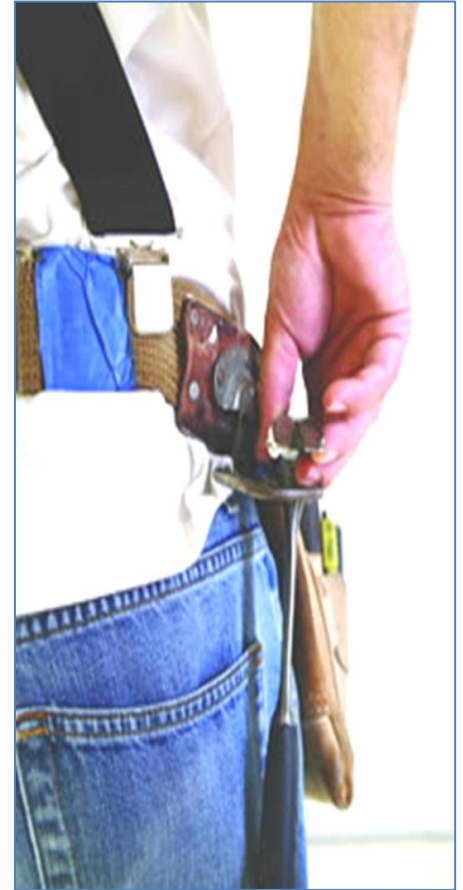
